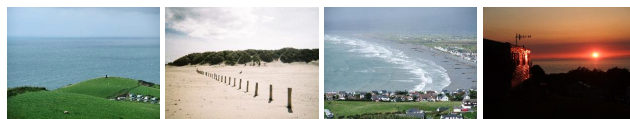

Out and About

At the edge of the village is Borth & Ynyslas Golf Course and Club. Ynyslas beach is a little further on. This has vast sand dunes which are boardwalked. It is here that you will find The Countryside of Wales Conservation and Activity Centre that hosts its own table of events throughout the year. The university town of Aberystwyth is less than 15 minutes away. Having both a narrow guage railway and cliff railway at the summit of which is the largest Camera Obscura in the world. There are beach activities and a Sunday Market at Clarach Bay or a Wednesday Market at Tre'r Ddol,. Within easy reach are 6 narrow gauge steam railways and The Centre for Alternative Technology at Machynlleth.
